




INTRODUCTION

We have to collect data of Child labor and planned to form policy with ILO and give to the government in written about the status quo of the child labor.</p>

ILO's representative	<p>Mr. Gadiraju. Lakshmi. Narsimhan, National Project Manager, ILO, New Delhi- He thanked to all participants and expressed his views that his organization is working in 16 countries and in India- Bihar, Chhattishgarh and Uttar Pradesh also to prevent child labour. ILO completed 100 yrs in the last year which objective has been to combat child labor at the global level. This is the oldest problem in the world. Most commonly it is found in the unorganized sectors. With the support of government and Civil societies we could be success to safe the children. He said about project MAP 16- M stands for Measurement, A stands for Awareness and L stands for policy based upon the ground level. He said after getting survey of child labour his organization will put it before the government and with the support of government and all you we will pave the way to combat child labor. Worry has to be</p> <p>   transformed into thinking.  </p> <p>Contractors take children outside like  in Uttar  Pradesh, Punjab, Hariyana ,Kolkatta etc. where the  children are greatly exploited. He cited the  government of India proclamation about to make  India free from child labour before 2015 but situation  remains a little bit the same. There isn't exact figure  of child labour. He called upon the media to take the  actual figure of child labour in Jamui district and  publish it so that everyone could know about the  statuesque of the child labour. He quoted Nelson  Mandela's poem on children. He advised to all to be  sensitive about to stop the child labour, it will be  happen if we facilitate the poor family to avail the  welfare schemes and aware them to not send their  children to earn money but send them to school. We  have to work hard for children safety and  development. Rehabilitation of child labour is a big  task.</p>

Group-5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Need to mention Mother's name, Monthly income of family, number of persons in family, mobile number of family member</li> <li>• Whether Family has got government's sponsored welfare schemes facility or not.</li> <li>• Whether family knows government's sponsored welfare schemes facility or not.</li> <li>• Whether child labor has enrollment in school or not.</li> <li>• The provision in Section 12 of the Act 1986 should be mentioned on the question paper.</li> <li>• Name of Employer and his signature should be removed on the questionnaire.</li> <li>• Need to get signature of Neighbors instead of present people at the work place.</li> </ul>
Group-6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Need to mention Mother's name, mobile number of guardian, age 6-18 should be on the questionnaire.</li> <li>• There should be police protection facility if the surveyors face insecurity at the time of survey.</li> <li>• Need of Identity card of Surveyors</li> <li>• Guardian should be aware about the importance of education</li> </ul>

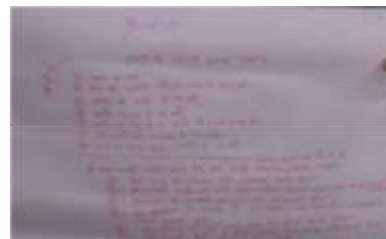
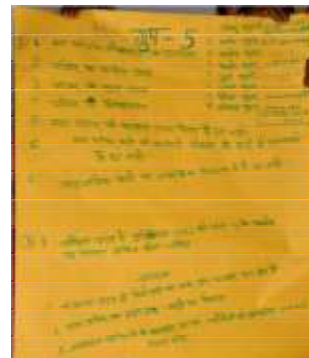
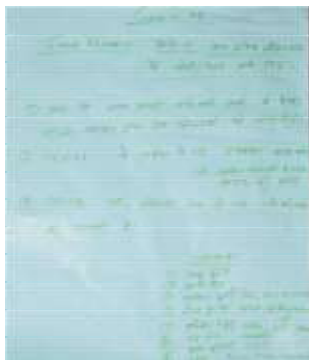
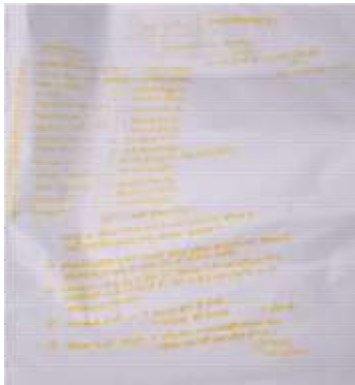


Conclusion/Vote of thanks
