money. He raided those factories and rescued children. Children are being deprived of their fundamental rights. Intellectuals, Rich & Enlightened people also have to come forward to eradicate child labour. He ensured to support NGOs to help to prevent children from child labor and make Nawada free from child labour.

Mr. Chadrashekhhar Azad, SDM, Razauli, Nawada- He said in this workshop that Nawada is the highest backward district.



Child labour, Child marriage, Child amusement are prevailing there. Poverty and Unemployment rate is high. About 1-1.5

lakh Children are working in Mica due to poverty. Children are also working at the brick kilns. They are migrating in other states to earn money to overcome their pathetic economic condition. He said that the government cannot control this alone, society as well as civil society organization will have to come forward to reduce the frequency of the child labour then after we can make Nawada free from child labour. He raided many places and rescued children from labor and some of those children are enrolled in private and government schools too. He said that awareness, will have to be brought for this. A lot of Workshop, Awareness program, Prabhat feri were organized by him to open the eyes of the society to combat the Child labour. He said that Rescue of Child isn't a big issue but to rehabilitate them is a challenge indeed and we could do for them together. He said that he will support NGOs to make Nawada free from Child labour.

Mr. Annu Kumar, SDO Sadar, Nawada- He said in his address that Children are working in Restaurant, Dhaba, Hotel and in private home also for some reasons. There is a provision



in the constitution for their rights and must have their rights. There is need to aware the

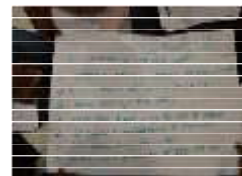
